necessary transportation infrastructure projects
through a voter-approved one-cent sales tax.

Your region's <u>project lists</u> were selected at regional roundtables of local elected officials, community members & stakeholders appointed by the <u>Heart of Georgia Altamaha Regional Commission</u>.

<u>Citizen Review Panels</u> of local residents appointed by the Lieutenant Governor or Georgia Speaker of the House meet at least three times per year to oversee the program's progress.

HOGA Completes 65 TIA Transportation Construction Projects in 2024

The TIA Team and local leaders are celebrating a successful 2024, with six TIA 1 projects and 59 TIA 2 projects completed. Overall, 99% of all TIA 1 projects and 11% of all TIA 2 projects have completed construction.

Completed projects include new traffic signals and improvements at three US 84 intersections in Jesup, the shoulder widening and resurfacing of 9.5 miles of Old Hawkinsville Road/West Blackshear Ferry Road in Laurens County and the conversion of 1.3 miles of Tuckers Grove Church Road in Johnson County from dirt to paved.

Project managers have planned an active 2025. Significant progress is expected on many projects like Toombs County's Lyons Bypass construction, the shoulder widening and resurfacing of Griffin Ferry Road in Emanuel County and the realignment of the Cyril Burkhalter Road & Mile Field Road intersection in Tattnall County.

Laurens County: US 441 Widening SR 117 to I-16

Contractors are nearly finished with roadside clearing activities. Motorists will also encounter utility crews relocating various lines in work zones along the construction corridor. #DriveAlert and watch for signage for safety!





Wheeler County: Springhill Road & Sandpit Road Resurfacing

This project's contractor, The Scruggs Company, has received 'notice to proceed' with construction. In coming weeks (when the weather permits) drivers will encounter crews doing initial tasks, including clearing the roadsides.



Jeff Davis County: Bell Telephone Road Resurfacing Bundle

Contractors recently completed major construction tasks for this project, which included asphalt patching and resurfacing four county roadways: Bell Telephone Road, Ira Graham Road, McCall Road and Claxton Road (pictured here). 30 roadways in total will be resurfaced in Jeff Davis County through HOGA's TIA 2 term.
