Southern Georgia Closes Out 2024 With 68% of TIA 1 Projects Complete

The TIA Team and local leaders are celebrating the end of a successful 2024, with 17 projects completed. This brings the overall total of completed transportation improvement projects to 102, or 68% of the total list of 151.

Completed project highlights include the bridge replacement on US 82 at Satilla River Overflow in Brantley County, the asphalt paving of Hightower Road/Cooper Road near Moody Air Force Base in Lowndes County, the bridge replacements on Scooterville Road and Omega Eldorado Road in Tift County and the shoulder widening and resurfacing of 5.5 miles of Johnson Lake Road in Bacon County.

Project managers have planned an active 2025. Significant progress is expected on many projects including improvements to the Interstate 75 interchange at Madison Highway in Lowndes County and the bridge replacements on US 84 at the Satilla River in Ware County.

Lowndes County: Interstate 75 at SR 31 Improvements

The two roundabouts under construction where the Interstate 75 ramps meet SR 31/Madison Highway are really taking shape. Drivers are urged to drive alert through the interchange, as multiple work teams may be stationed throughout the work zone corridor at any time.



Pierce County: US 84 Intersection & Signal Improvements from County Farm Road to New School Road

Contractors have started construction on this project, with crews clearing and grubbing the work site. Motorists will encounter large trucks hauling material to the site, so drivers should stay back from them and maintain a moderate speed through the work zone for safety.
