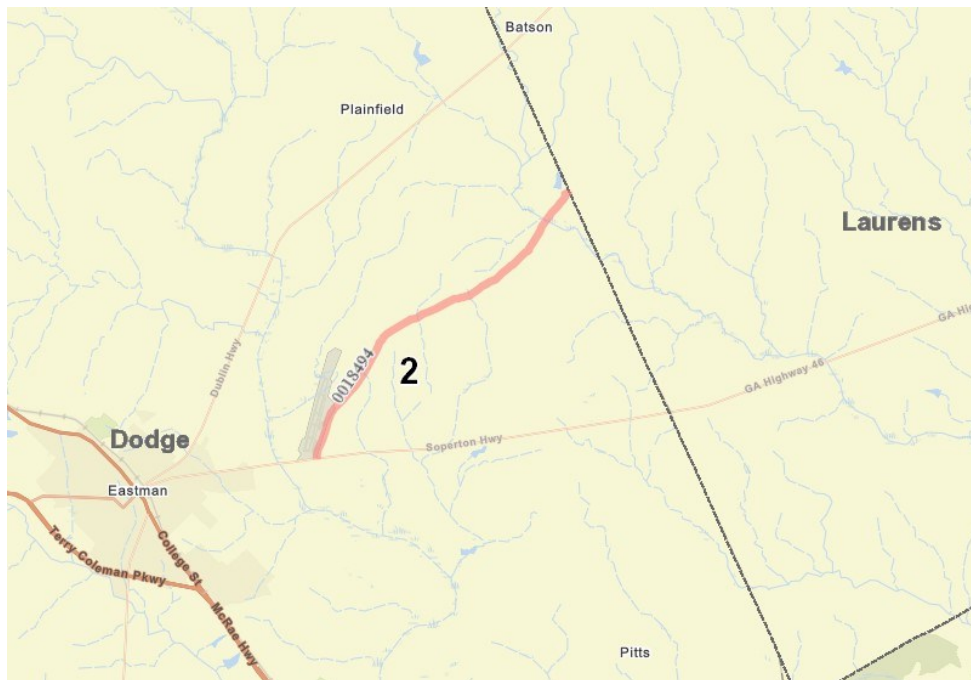

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Heart of Georgia Altamaha Region: Georgia DOT awards construction contract for Dodge County resurfacing project



EASTMAN, Georgia — The Georgia Department of Transportation (Georgia DOT) has awarded 13 new contracts for construction projects across the state as part of their February 2025 bidding process. One was for a TIA-funded project in the Heart of Georgia Altamaha region. It is:

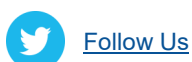
Dodge County: this project would resurface and widen shoulders on 6.35 miles of Airport Road from SR 46 to the Laurens County line. The contract was awarded to The Scruggs Company of Hahira for \$1.7 million. The project is expected to be completed at the end of winter 2026.
