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Southern Georgia Region: Georgia DOT awards construction contract for Clinch County bridge project



ATLANTA, Georgia — The Georgia Department of Transportation (Georgia DOT) has awarded 22 new contracts for construction projects across the state as part of their October 2025 bidding process. One was for a TIA-funded project in the Southern Georgia region. It is:




- Clinch County: this project will replace the two-lane Homerville Bypass/CR 194 bridge and its approaches at Woodyard Creek. The contract was awarded to Griffin Grading & Concrete, LLC of Cordele for \$2.08 million. The project is expected to be completed in the early spring of 2027.
