Georgia's **Transportation Investment Act (TIA) Program** provides a way for regions to fund
necessary transportation infrastructure projects
through a voter-approved one-cent sales tax.

Your region's <u>project lists</u> were selected at regional roundtables of local elected officials, community members & stakeholders appointed by the <u>Central</u> Savannah River Area Regional Commission.

<u>Citizen Review Panels</u> of local residents appointed by the Lieutenant Governor or Georgia Speaker of the House meet at least three times per year to oversee the program's progress.



Citizens Review Panels: Your Local Representatives in TIA Projects & Progress

Every Georgia region participating in TIA has a group of local leaders who monitor the program on behalf of that region's residents, ensuring that projects are completed, budgeting is responsible and quality is ensured as directed in the official TIA manual.

Each member of the citizens review panel is selected by either the lieutenant governor or the speaker of the Georgia House of Representatives. All of their meeting presentations and their annual reports to the Georgia Department of Revenue are posted online as public information at www.ga-tia.com. Just click on 'Program Reports' to find the documents for each TIA region.

Burke County: US 25 at US 25 Bypass Intersection Improvements

Contractors have completed major construction tasks on this Waynesboro project. The addition of new turn lanes and a concrete median will make the intersection safer and improve the flow of traffic through the area.





Richmond County: 5th Street, 6th Street & 13th Street Downtown Improvements

This past quarter, contractors completed major construction tasks for these three projects. Upgrades included resurfacing roadways, refurbishing concrete sidewalk, curb and gutter, adding lighting and reconstructing the sewer system. The downtown's pedestrians and drivers alike will be safer with the new and improved facilities.



Columbia County: SR 388/Horizon South Parkway Widening

Utility crews are finishing up their work moving the various water, power and communication lines through the project limits. Utility construction activities require a lot of coordination, as many of the cables, wires, pipes and more are positioned close to each other.
