Georgia's **Transportation Investment Act (TIA) Program** provides a way for regions to fund
necessary transportation infrastructure projects
through a voter-approved one-cent sales tax.

Your region's <u>project lists</u> were selected by regional roundtables made up of local elected officials, community members & stakeholders appointed by the <u>River Valley Regional Commission</u>.

<u>Citizen Review Panels</u> of local residents appointed by the Lieutenant Governor or Georgia Speaker of the House meet at least three times per year to oversee the program's progress.



Citizens Review Panels: Your Local Representatives in TIA Projects & Progress

Every Georgia region participating in TIA has a group of local leaders who monitor the program on behalf of that region's residents, ensuring that projects are completed, budgeting is responsible and quality is ensured as directed in the official TIA manual.

Each member of the citizens review panel is selected by either the lieutenant governor or the speaker of the Georgia House of Representatives. All of their meeting presentations and their annual reports to the Georgia Department of Revenue are posted online as public information at www.ga-tia.com. Sumter & Harris Counties: Public Info Open Houses Bring Out Crowds of Citizens

In the past quarter, residents with questions and concerns turned out to open houses for Sumter County's projects widening US 280 and Harris County's projects improving SR 315. Project designers were encouraged by the discussions and will respond to each attendee with additional information.





Muscogee County: Columbus Airport Runway Improvements

Contractors reconstructing Runway 6-24 used the mostly-dry summer months to make good progress. Working in sections and starting on the north end, teams removed the old layers of gravel and pavement and then laid new material for a smooth durable surface. The airport is closed to traffic while the project is underway, so completing the project in a timely manner is particularly important.



Muscogee County: Cusseta/Old Cusseta Road Improvements

Columbus's Interstate 185 interchange at Old Cusseta Road is quickly taking shape, with contractors paving two new ramps, grading another ramp and widening the overpass during the past quarter. Drivers are cautioned when driving through the work zone, as crews continue widening and realigning Old Cusseta Road.
