Project Totals for Year-End 2025 Show Steady Progress Throughout CSRA Region

In its recent 2025 Annual Report, Citizens Review Panel members and TIA administrators reported to the Georgia State Assembly that the CSRA's construction activity and collections were steady through the

past year, and all projects on the region's final investment list are on track to be delivered successfully.

46 projects were completed in 2025. Of the CSRA's 246 total projects, 135 or 55% are now complete, 52 are under construction and 47 are in preconstruction phases.

Columbia County: SR 28/Furys Ferry Road Widening


Sky-high views show the progress contractors have made widening this busy corridor from Evans to Locks Road to the South Carolina line. A number of crews are active, grading and building new roadway as well as setting concrete for sidewalk, curb and gutter. Teams are also working occasional night shifts, so motorists should always drive with caution.



Georgia's **Transportation Investment Act (TIA) Program** provides a way for regions to fund necessary transportation infrastructure projects through a voter-approved one-cent sales tax.

Your region's project lists were selected at regional roundtables of local elected officials, community members & stakeholders appointed by the [Central Savannah River Area Regional Commission](#).

[Citizen Review Panels](#) of local residents appointed by the Lieutenant Governor or Georgia Speaker of the House meet at least three times per year to oversee the program's progress.



Warren County: Four Roadway Resurfacing Projects

Contractors have nearly completed resurfacing activities on sections of Little Briar Creek Church Road, Norwood-Camak Road, Cadley Road and Garthright Road (pictured here). Local residents will see crews doing final striping on these roads in coming weeks.



Richmond County: New Railroad Spur Track at Augusta Corporate Park

Contractors have started grading and leveling land for a new spur track at Augusta Corporate Park that will connect to the nearby Norfolk Southern Railroad track. The project will improve connectivity at the park, providing a direct way for businesses to ship and receive freight materials and products.
